his quarters project spotlight is
Cottrell Trailers with Choate Construction. The job is currently at 70%
completion with a contract of \$14,000,000
The massive scope on this project includes:
580 Tons of rebar installation, 200 spread
footings, close to 600,000 SF of slab on grade
concrete, 217,848 SF of smooth tilt panel
walls, and 22,356 LF of 2" reveal. This is one
of the more interesting tilt jobs that GGC has
had due to the scope. We appreciate the field
team that has made this job a success for
both the GGC team and for the general contractor.
