Project spotlight: Cottrell Trailers—tilt



This quarters project spotlight is Cottrell Trailers with Choate Construction. The job is currently at 70% completion with a contract of **\$14,000,000**. The massive scope on this project includes: **580 Tons** of rebar installation, 200 spread footings, close to **600,000 SF** of slab on grade concrete, **217,848 SF** of smooth tilt panel walls, and **22,356 LF** of 2" reveal. This is one of the more interesting tilt jobs that GGC has had due to the scope. We appreciate the field team that has made this job a success for both the GGC team and for the general contractor.
