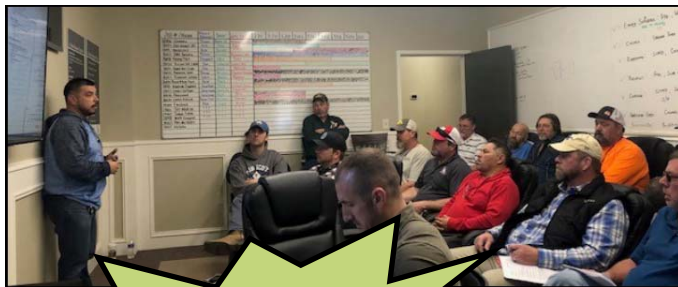


## Backlog Growth

GGC helped "Pave the way."



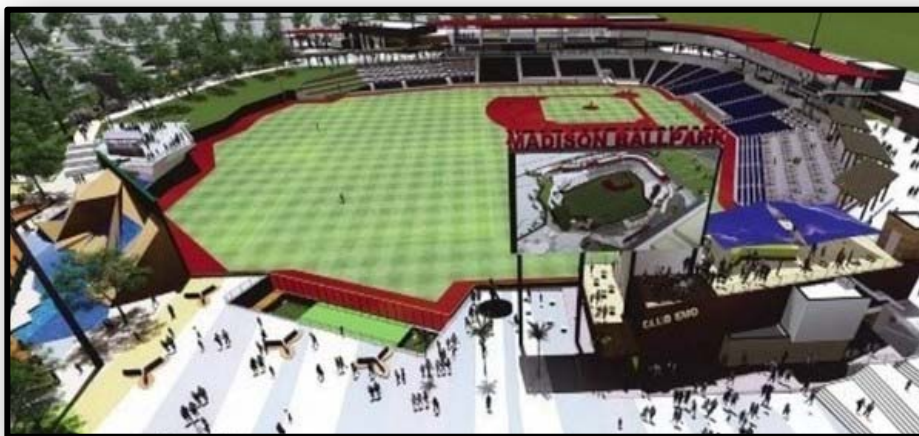
