Since 2019 GGC has been working in multiple areas of the massive eight-building data center campus.

The work has included: Massive footing excavation for the 8A building, Placement and finishing for the 7A and 8A buildings, multiple areas of added scope including site scope that was included in multiple contracts.

Throughout the course of the MNK Projects, GGC completed scope in the following areas within the complex: **MNK6B, MNK7A, MNK7A Site, MNK8A, MNK8A Site, GCUB Building, MNKHUB2 hardscape package, and MNK-HUB2 masonry scope.** **Structural**— The overall square footage poured between the 7A and 8A buildings exceeded 1.165 million square feet of concrete and multiple other contracts picked up from various trades. Pertaining to **Hard-scape**— Quoted by Anthony Ureno *“We’re super appreciative of the opportunity to help with final finishes for such a legacy project”*. GGC’s team completed over 270,660 SF of asphalt installation between the 7A and 8A sites with several thousand linear feet of curb and gutter, along with specialty coatings and striping for the roadways. Some finishing touches were completed at MNKHUB2 such as: a large composite wood deck installation, plank pavers, and perimeter sidewalks for the building entrances. GGC appreciates the team support that made this job a success from the Preconstruction team, structural team, and hardscape team. Thank you all for your hard work and dedication!
